Financial assistance is offered to help low-income households who face disconnection from gas and electricity.



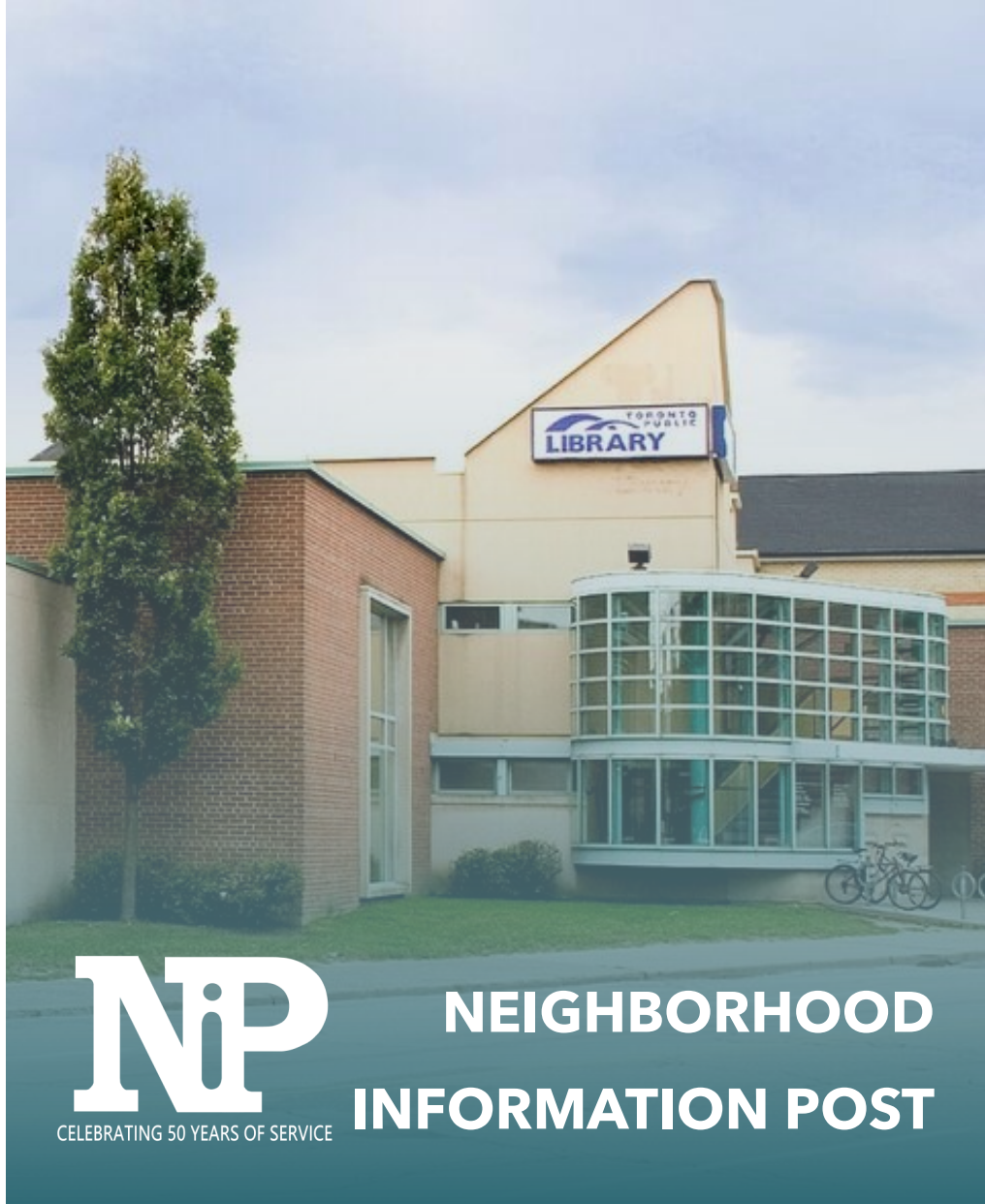
### HOUSING TRUSTESHIP PROGRAM
